Subject	Centralized Control & Freeze Option for Deduction Master				
Description	Introduce an Advance Control to define a Primary Property ID for VAT and Deduction setup. Once a property is mapped to a Primary Property, the ADD and SAVE buttons in VAT and Deduction Master should be disabled for that property, ensuring that configurations are maintained only at the Primary Property. This will allow multiple properties to follow a single setup while still supporting chains with properties across different countries where tax structures may vary.

Remarks					

1. Background

Currently, VAT and Deduction Master setups are configured independently at the property level. There is no mechanism to centralize or control these configurations across multiple properties within the same chain.

In practical scenarios, certain properties within a chain require the same VAT and deduction configuration, while others may belong to different countries and follow different tax structures.

2. Existing Limitation

- VAT and Deduction Master can be configured separately for each property.
- No option to define a **primary property** whose configuration can be used by other properties.
- No restriction to prevent additional setup once the configuration should be controlled centrally.

3. Proposed Enhancement

1. Advance Control – Primary Property ID

Introduce an **Advance Control setting** where a **Primary Property ID** can be defined for VAT and Deduction setup.

- The selected Primary Property will act as the **master configuration property**.
- Other properties can inherit the configuration from this Primary Property.

2. Restriction on Setup for Linked Properties

Once a property is mapped to a **Primary Property ID** in Advance Control:

- The **ADD** and **SAVE** buttons in **VAT Master** and **Deduction Master** should be **disabled** for those properties.
- Users will not be able to create or modify VAT/Deduction configurations locally.
- They will only be able to use the setup defined in the Primary Property.

4. Example Scenario

Chain contains:

- **Property A**
- **Property B**
- **Property C**

Requirement:

- VAT and Deduction setup is defined only in **Property A** (Primary Property).

- **Property B** and **Property C** should follow the same configuration.

Once Property A is defined as the **Primary Property ID**:

- VAT/Deduction setup is maintained only in **Property A**.
- **ADD** and **SAVE** options are disabled for Property B and Property C.
- These properties automatically use the configuration defined in Property A.

5. Reason for Property-Level Control Instead of Chain-Level

A single chain may contain properties across multiple countries (e.g., India, Sri Lanka, Malaysia).

Tax structures differ by country, so a **chain-level setup cannot be universally applied**.

Therefore, the control should be implemented using a **Primary Property-based configuration** rather than chain-wide configuration.

6. Expected Benefits

- Controlled and centralized tax configuration
- Reduced duplication of setup across properties
- Flexibility for multi-country chains
- Prevention of inconsistent VAT/Deduction configuration
